Self-Renouncing Love

How to Live Like Jesus John 15: 4-12

- People can argue with you over your theology, doctrine, lifestyle... But who can argue against unselfish, disinterested love? (Thought from The Desire of Ages, pp. 141, 142).

- Heb 13:17 Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.

- In reading and explaining the Scriptures you should be very careful not to depart from the expressed and established views which have been given by those in the faith who have sought for truth as for hid treasure, who have endured any labor and spared no expense, who have in the fear of God presented a harmonious chain of truth. {3MR 261.1}

General Conference

At times, when a small group of men entrusted with the general management of the work have, in the name of the General Conference, sought to carry out unwise plans and to restrict God's work, I have said that I could no longer regard the voice of the General Conference, represented by these few men, as the voice of God. But this is not saying that the decisions of a General Conference composed of an assembly of duly appointed, representative men from all parts of the field should not be respected. God has ordained that the representatives of His church from all parts of the earth, when assembled in a General Conference, shall have authority. The error that some are in danger of committing is in giving to the mind and judgment of one man, or of a small group of men, the full measure of authority and influence that God has vested in His church in the judgment and voice of the General Conference assembled to plan for the prosperity and advancement of His work. {9T 260.2} (1909)

Purpose of Law/ Torah

- 1Ti 1:8 But we know that the law is good, if a man use it lawfully;
- 1Ti 1:9 Knowing this, that the law is <u>not</u> made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,
- 1Ti 1:10 For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine;
- 1Ti 1:11 According to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust.

Laws

- Christ and the Law of Moses
 - If man had kept the law of God, as given to Adam after his fall, preserved by Noah, and observed by Abraham, there would have been no necessity for the ordinance of circumcision.
 - And if the descendants of Abraham had kept the **covenant**, of which circumcision was a sign, they would never have been seduced into idolatry, nor would it have been necessary for them to suffer a life of bondage in Egypt;
 - they would have kept God's law in mind, and there would have been no necessity for it to be proclaimed from Sinai or engraved upon the tables of stone.
 - And had the people practiced the principles of the Ten Commandments, there would have been no need of the additional directions given to Moses. {PP 364.2}

Law according to Simchat Torah Beit Midrash

- Hb Torah Yarah to cast, point = teachings, the directions pointed out by the teacher
- Ex a parent's torah is a set of teachings or instructions, to train and bring the children to maturity, to set them on the correct path.
- Contrast = law is a set of rules that if not observed correctly will result in punishment and there is no room for teaching.
- Command/ Orders Vs Directed / guide (Hb 6680 tsavah)

Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the *law*, till all be

 In consequence of continual transgression, the moral law was repeated in awful grandeur from Sinai. Christ gave to Moses religious precepts which were to govern the everyday life. These statutes were explicitly given to guard the ten commandments. They were **not** shadowy types to pass away with the death of Christ. They were to be binding upon man in every age as long as time should last. These commands were enforced by the power of the moral law, and they clearly and definitely explained that law. {RH, May 6, 1875 par. 10} 1 BC 1104:6

More Plainly



- Read carefully all of Deuteronomy 26, also chapters 27 and 28; for here are stated plainly the blessings of obedience. {RH, December 25, 1900 par. 6}
- These directions, which the Lord gave to His people, express the <u>principles of the law</u> of the kingdom of God, and they are <u>made specific</u>, so that the minds of the people may not be left in ignorance and uncertainty... {RH, December 25, 1900 par. 7}





 The principles set forth in Deuteronomy for the instruction of Israel <u>are to be followed by</u> <u>God's people to the end of time</u>. True prosperity is dependent on the continuance of our <u>covenant relationship</u> with God... {PK 570.2}





The Sabbath Question



- The Sabbath question is to be the issue in the great final conflict, in which all the world will act a part. Men have honored Satan's principles above the **principles that rule in the heavens**. They have accepted the spurious sabbath, which Satan has exalted as the sign of his authority. But God has set His seal upon His royal requirement. Each Sabbath institution, both true and false, **bears the name of its author**, an ineffaceable mark that **shows the authority of each**. {7BC 977.7}
- The great decision now to be made by every one is, whether he will receive the mark of the beast and his image, or the seal of the living and true God (ST March 22, 1910) {7BC 977.8}

God's Authority



 God could have destroyed Satan and his sympathizers as easily as one can cast a pebble to the earth; but He did not do this. Rebellion was not to be overcome by force. Compelling power is found only under Satan's government. The Lord's principles are not of this order. His authority rests upon goodness, mercy, and love; and the presentation of these principles is the means to be used. God's government is moral, and truth and love are to be the prevailing power. {DA 759.1} "It is Finished"

Reasons for the Divine Choice of the Sabbath as Covenant Symbol



- 1) Ownership Seal, Ex 20: 8-11
